My ex-partner and I are both HIV positive and she was the first person I disclosed to. Her insistence upon unprotected sex was a great worry to me because since I decided take ownership of my situation, I have been determined to keep my viral load down and not to reinfect myself. I have disclosed in my community and because of the lack of knowledge there, I am afraid I will have a hard time when trying to find another partner.

I live in a very small village, Gaselwane R35 Prieska Manjenje 4 where a mobile clinic only comes on Mondays, this is a challenge because the clinic deals with emergencies and HIV testing is not considered an emergency because there might not be immediate signs of illness. There is also still a lot of education that needs to happen so that when the service is available then people can access it.
